



Buggy/Trolley Dispensation Policy

Medical Dispensation List

England Golf encourages participation in golf by all players regardless of disabilities.

“Disability” shall have the same meaning as section 6 of the Equality Act 2010.

A person has a disability if they have a physical or mental impairment which has a substantial and long-term adverse effect on their ability to conduct normal day-to-day activities.

When Course conditions restrict the use of buggies, only Members on the Medical Dispensation List (MDL) will be permitted the use of a buggy.

Members eligible to register on the (MDL) must have one of the following:

1. a ‘Valid medical confirmation of disability,’ which is a valid medical certificate from a registered general practitioner or consultant; or
2. a ‘Blue Badge.’

All Members who wish to register on the MDL should produce their blue badge or medical certificate to the General Manager (GM).

In all cases any member who has restricted mobility due to injury or age and cannot play golf without the use of a buggy or trolley and wishes to register on the (MDL), should speak directly with the (GM).

The (MDL) will be maintained by the office and a copy held in the Professionals shop.

On the day of hiring the buggy, **all visitors** claiming medical dispensation must produce either a blue card or a valid medical certificate.
