

Clubhouse Code of Conduct for Behaviour and Dress

Olton Golf Club promotes high standards of etiquette, and respect for others, throughout all aspects of the game of golf and membership of our club. Our dress code looks to make members, guests and visitors feel welcome and comfortable within our club. With this in mind, the dress code simply outlines a smart, neat and clean, standard of dress both on and off the course.

It is hoped that everyone will assist in maintaining the high standards expected both on the Course and in the Clubhouse, respectfully maintaining the traditions of our club.

Dress Code in the Clubhouse

- Please ensure all clothing, including jeans, are smart, neat and clean, not torn or soiled
- It is good manners to remove hats and caps within the clubhouse
- Please use the Drying Rooms for wet waterproof and outdoor clothing
- Clean golfing footwear with soft spikes is acceptable in main Bar at designated times
- All footwear must be smart and clean, but additionally for men, open-toed sandals/flip flops are not acceptable

Functions and Club Events

All Club functions and events require appropriate standard of attire and the dress code for each event will included when promoting the function or event.

Smoking Policy

Smoking, including Vaping and use of electronic cigarettes, is not permitted in the Clubhouse

Out of respect for all, please take care not to cause offence when smoking outside on the Patio

Mobile Phone Policy and Etiquette – Clubhouse

➤ Keep on Silent / Vibrate	➤ Do not make calls in the Bar areas/Restaurant / Entrance Hallway
➤ Use freely as Diary/Email/Text / Web Browser	➤ No audible Ringtones
➤ Only take or make calls in the Locker Rooms/Patio/ Changing Room/ Lobbies	
(Organisers of private events may decide to allow phone use in their exclusive areas, usually the Heaton or Lily Moore Lounges.)
