



Dress Code – General Guidance

Olton Golf Club promotes high standards of etiquette, and respect for others, throughout all aspects of the game of golf and membership of our club. Our dress code looks to make members, guests and visitors feel welcome and comfortable within our club. The dress code outlines a smart, neat, and clean, standard of dress both on and off the course.

It is hoped that everyone will assist in maintaining the high standards expected both on the Course and in the Clubhouse, respectfully maintaining the traditions of our club.

Golf Course and practice facilities.

Acceptable:

- Recognised golf shoes must be worn.
- Golf shirts must be tucked in and have a collar.
- All golf-branded golf attire.
- Shorts and skirts must be tailored and designed for golf.
- Ladies' tops with a collar may be sleeveless.

Recognised golfing attire does mean that we can follow the modern trends of the sport including sports leggings and hooded tops as long as they are a recognised golf brand

Clubhouse; Bar, Heaton Lounge, Snug, Boardroom, Snooker Room Patio Area.

Acceptable:

- Smart casual dress - includes denim jeans (but not ripped or frayed), branded golf wear with or without a collar, any other collared shirt, or a roll neck top.
- Ladies' tops with a collar may be sleeveless and any Ladies' top specifically designed to be worn outside a waistband.
- All Men's shirts must be tucked into the waistband.
- Clean golf attire: clean golf shoes are permitted in the bar only.
- The dress code for functions will be specified for each event (Casual; Smart Casual; Formal; Black Tie/Evening Wear).
- Hats, waterproofs, and outerwear are only permitted on the patio.
